BOOK BINGO 2020

A challenge isn't really a challenge unless there are some rules and guidelines:

1. Be awesome. If you're not, this isn't going to work.
2. The challenge runs from July 13th to September 30th, 2020. If you want to participate, you can join in at any time!
3. Reading and re-reading both count toward crossing off boxes! Either way, the Book Bingo box action must be performed between 7/13/20 and 9/30/20.
4. You can use one book to cross off multiple squares on your Bingo card. (Ex: A novel with a BIPOC protagonist published in 2020 by an author with the same first name as you that is also your BFF's favorite book would count for four squares.)
5. Need help finding links to online museum tours, accessing Overdrive's Community Reads collection, making an appointment for curbside delivery, or figuring out what the Bechdel Test is? Ask/email Miki or Hilary– we're happy to help! Or, check out our website and/or Facebook for ideas and inspiration.
6. The prize winners will be chosen at random from all eligible participants. To qualify, you must complete a BINGO (at least one row, column or diagonal line.) Overachievers (those who complete multiple BINGOS) will receive one entry per completed BINGO, plus a bonus ticket if the entire card is filled.
7. Remember to claim your ticket for each BINGO. Due to the ongoing pandemic, the claiming of tickets will be done virtually by emailing Assistant Director Miki Wolfe at mwolfe@ocln.org or Information Services Library Hilary Umbreit at humbreit@ocln.org with a picture of the BINGO card attached.
