BOOK BINGO 2017 RULES

A challenge isn't really a challenge unless there are some rules and guidelines:

1. Be awesome. If you're not, this isn't going to work.
2. The challenge runs from July 1 to August 31, 2017. If you want to participate, you can join in at any time!
3. Reading and re-reading both count! Either way, the book must be read between 7/1/17 and 8/31/17, cover to cover.
4. This year, in a rule change, you can use a book to cross off multiple squares on your BINGO card. (Ex: A book published in 2017 with a green cover written by a local author who is under 35 years of age would count for four squares.)
5. Curious about how to read an eBook, how to access Zinio, or how to start learning a language with Mango? Ask a Library staff member— we're happy to help! (You don't necessarily need an eReader to read or listen to an electronic book from the library. All you need is a computer and an internet connection, or a device that will run either of the library eReading apps: OverDrive or hoopla.)
6. The prize winners will be chosen at random from all eligible participants. To qualify, you must complete a BINGO (at least one row, column or diagonal line.) Overachievers (those who complete multiple BINGOS) will receive one entry per completed BINGO, plus a bonus ticket if the entire card is filled.
7. Claim your raffle ticket for each BINGO from the Sharon Public Library Adult Circulation or Reference desks.
8. This isn't a race, but don't be afraid to brag about your reads to other players. This will be seen as encouragement, of course.
